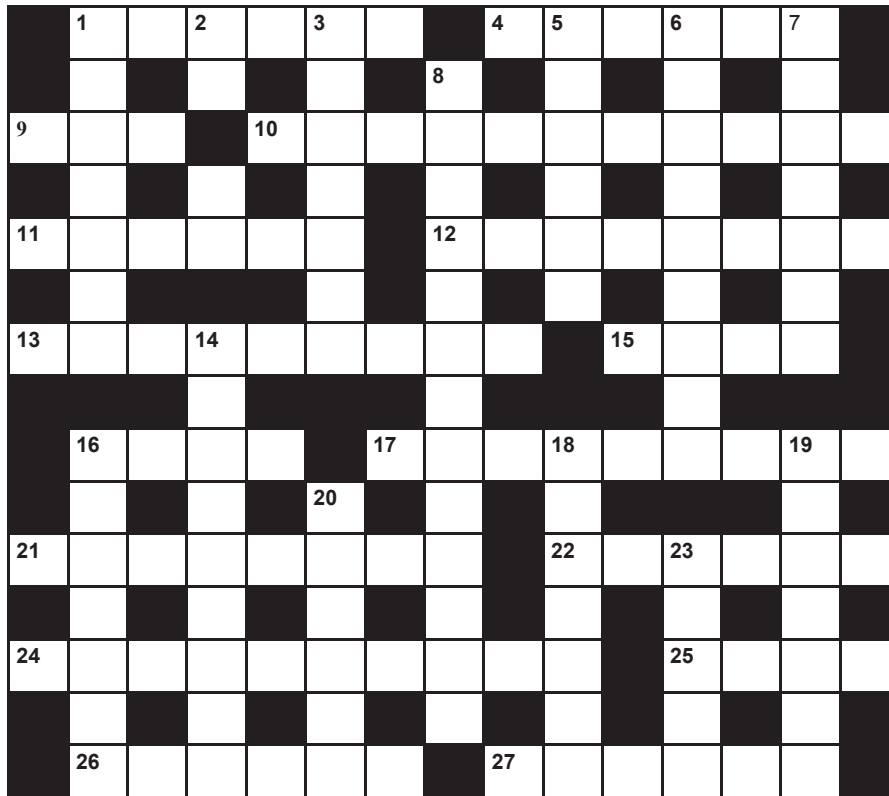


# A Taste of Trafford

| 9  | Rolls of soft bread (4)   | 3  | Hard fruit of a palm tree (7)  |
| 10 | A pastry filled with currants and raisins (7,3)                     | 5  | Thin slice of bacon (6)  |
| 11 | A dried grape (6)   | 6  | Pauses from work to have a drink (3, 6)  |
| 12 | Frozen dessert containing cream, sugar & flavouring (3, 5)          | 7  | Minced meat stuffed in casings (7)   |
